NO LATE ENTRIES OR DAY-OF-EVENT ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Past **Junior Miss** (this age group was previously in with the Junior Miss Pageant) overall winners are not eligible to enter. **Contestants must live in the Carthage R-9 school district and provide proof of residence if requested.**

All contestants will be required to wear **BLUE OR BLACK JEANS**, any type of shoes (tennis, boots, sandals) and any type of hair decoration (bows, hats, ribbons, etc.) are acceptable. The shirt is to be a **WHITE T-SHIRT, LONG OR SHORT SLEEVE**. These can be decorated with iron-on Maple Leaves or any other design you wish.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Child must live in the Carthage / Avilla School District.
Ages 10 to 14 years old ON OR BEFORE OCT. 1, 2010.
Past Junior Miss overall winners are not eligible to enter.

2. Costume consists of jeans & t-shirt only!
Jeans only, color does not matter
T-shirt must be white but can be long/short sleeve & may be decorated in any way.
For example,
t-shirts may have a Maple Leaf drawing, bows, lace, etc.
Tennis shoes, boots, any footwear is acceptable
Any hair style is acceptable
Accessories such as hats, jewelry, etc. are optional

3. Judging will be done with 50 points possible for modeling and 50 points for interview.
As a portion of their interview the contestant will be asked to submit a 1 to 2 paragraph essay on what Maple Leaf means to them or what they enjoy about the Maple Leaf festival with their entry form by September 29, 2010. The essay can be hand written or typed. This will be given to the judges prior to their interview time to be read and scored.

A **\$15.00 entry fee** will be charged to cover the cost of the building, awards, and administrative expenses. Awards will be given for the top three in each age division with the option to give more awards should entries warrant.
